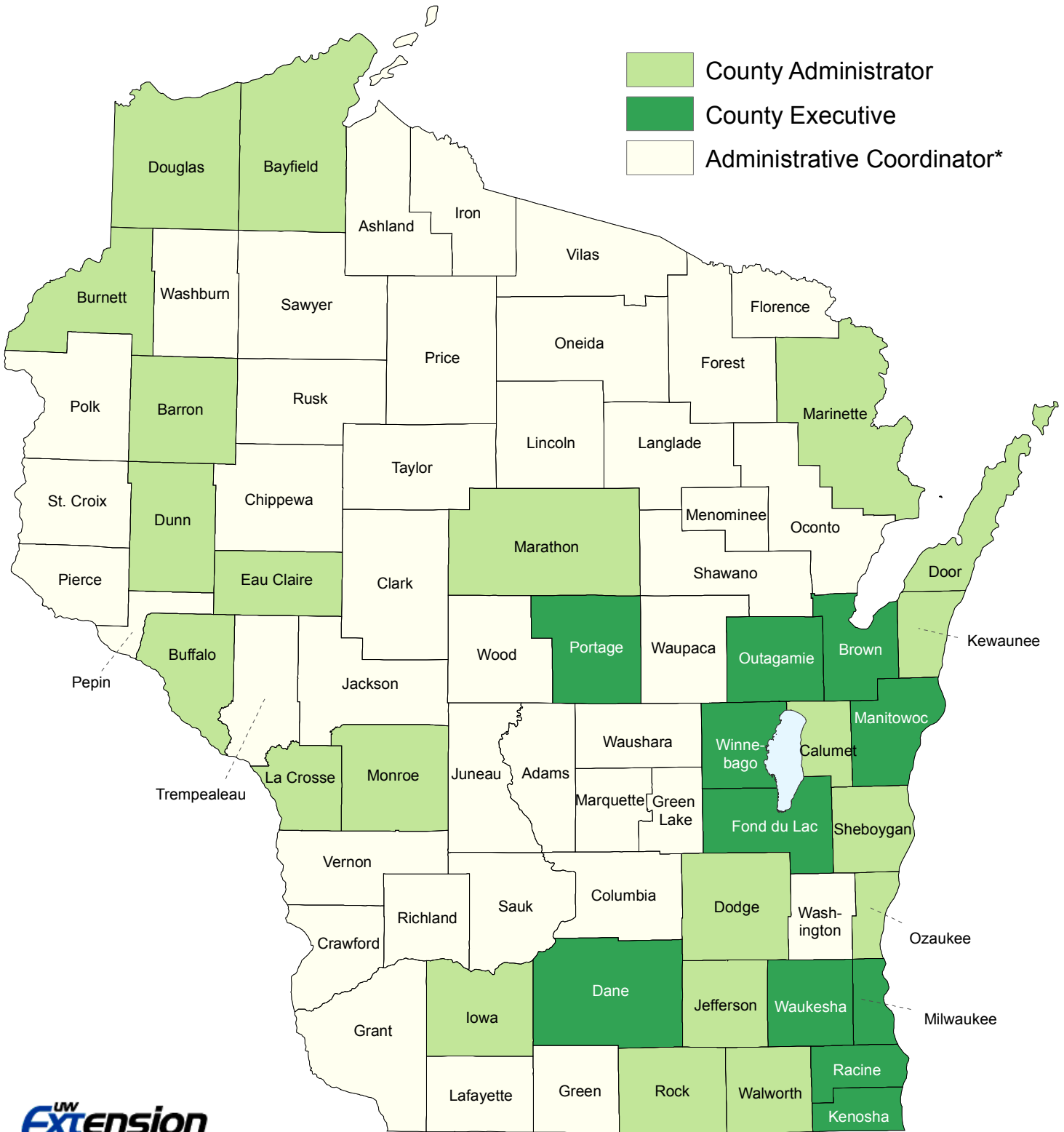


Wisconsin County Executives, Coordinators and Administrators



*NOTE: Wisconsin Statute 59.19 requires that any county which has not created the position of County Executive or County Administrator must appoint an Administrative Coordinator of the County. In some cases, a specific and separate Administrative Coordinator, other than the Chairman of the Board, has been designated.
